



Cancellation Policy Due to a Positive Case of COVID-19

Our priority is to protect the health of everyone who comes to The Whidbey Institute, including guests, program leaders, practitioners, and staff. The Whidbey Institute respectfully requires that you may not attend if:

- You are positive for Covid-19
- You have symptoms of Covid-19 and/or awaiting test results at the start of your retreat
- You have knowingly been exposed to, or lived with someone who had Covid-19 during the 14 days prior to your retreat

A refund will be issued for the cost of lodging but not for the cost of meals if canceled within two weeks prior to the event date. Our kitchen purchases food in accordance to exact numbers of participants one week prior to the event date and is unable to recoup losses from last minute cancellations.

Tuition refunds will be left up to the discretion of individual program leaders. Please contact them directly for their individual policy.
